## Relative Clauses

	Pronouns-Adverbs	
We use relative clauses to describe / refer to person / object / place / thing / possession in the main clause	who / that which / that where when whose why	people objects/animals/ideas place time possession reason

<b>Defining relative clause</b> who, which, whose, where, when, why, that	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It gives information <u>essential</u> to the meaning of the main sentence</li> <li>It is <u>not</u> put in commas</li> <li>The relative pronoun/ adverb can be omitted <u>only</u> when it is the <u>object</u> of the relative clause</li> </ul>
<b>Non-defining relative clause</b> who, whom, which, whose, where, when	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It gives extra information which is <u>not essential</u> to the meaning of the main sentence</li> <li>it is put in commas</li> <li>The relative pronoun <u>cannot</u> be omitted</li> </ul>
<b>Notes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Whose is never omitted</li> <li><b>That</b> can be used instead of <i>who</i>, <i>whom</i>, or <i>which</i> but it is never used after commas or prepositions.</li> </ul>

Notes	<i>That</i> can be used instead of <i>who</i> , <i>whom</i> , or <i>which</i> but it is never used after commas or prepositions.	Dr Daniels, <b>who/that</b> specialises in brain disorders, is a bestselling author of numerous books on psychology.
	<i>Whose</i> is never omitted.	The hospital <b>where</b> I used to work was a private one.
	With <i>when</i> and <i>where</i> we do not need a preposition.	The patient's condition has improved considerably, <b>which</b> was rather unexpected.
	<i>Which</i> may also refer to a whole sentence.	The bridge collapsed after the heavy rain, <b>which</b> was rather unexpected.
	Prepositions before relative pronouns are mostly used in formal English.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ The man to <b>whom</b> I spoke is my cardiologist → <i>formal</i></li> <li>◆ The man I spoke to is my cardiologist → <i>colloquial</i></li> </ul>
